

TRISODIUM PHOSPHATE TYPES 18, 19

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Trisodium Phosphate Dodecahydrate is a white crystalline non-flammable substance with strong alkaline reaction and bulk density of 900 – 1000 g/dm³. It is odourless and easily soluble in water.

PRODUCT APPLICATION

This product is used as softening agent against corrosion or scaling prevention in chemical water treatment. It is also used in the production of detergents, in cleaning compositions and synthetic rubber production. It is also used for additional softening of boiler water, as a polishing and degreasing agent in metal surface treatment and as a colour buffer in textile production.

TRANSPORTATION AND STORAGE

The product can shipped in:

- plastic bags of 25 kg
- big bags of 1000 kg

Delivery - one-way pallets mostly of 1000 kg net weight and wrapped in foil. During transportation, the product must be protected against weather influences.

Storage - must be stored in dry place with temperature lower than 35°C and should be covered. Important is to keep the product from contamination and moisture.

Shelf life: 15 months from production date when stored properly.
